Informational announcement by the New York City Department of Environmental Protection on their amnesty program

The New York City Department of Environmental Protection informed the Environment and Parks Committee about their amnesty program. This is a temporary water bill amnesty program to help New Yorkers save up to \$150 million of interest when they pay their overdue water bills. The limited time program will forgive up to 100 percent of interest when customers pay a portion or all of their outstanding water bills. With nearly 200,000 customers owing a combined \$1.2 billion in water bill charges to New York City Department of Environmental Protection, this program will help New Yorkers both clear their debt and save money, while ensuring that the city can continue to invest in and maintain the city's critical water infrastructure. The amnesty program, authorized by the New York City Water Board, will only run for 90 days, from January 30, 2023 to April 30, 2023.
