Lariely Sanchez, Principal at Kipp Freedom Middle School, located at 1825 Prospect Avenue reported safety concerns for the students at the school. Ms. Sanchez reported there have been several parent and student altercations. She is seeking support from the Community Board for guidance.

As a result, Carmen Rivera reached out to the Commander at the 48th Precinct. A Zoom call took place on 11/17/22 with the District Manager, Carmen Rivera, Lariely Sanchez and Commander Joseph DeLeo. A discussion took place with all in attendance. The principal and the Commander will meet to discuss how NYPD can mediate the situation. Ms. Sanchez will report back to the Community Board.

On 11/17, Carmen Rivera set up an additional interview with the applicant for 2363 Arthur Avenue. At the meeting, the Board's District Manager shared that the Belmont BID had just shared with him a copy of the applicant's temporary license from July to November 22. The applicant explained that he had renewed his temporary license several times and that it was still active. Carmen Rivera then made a motion to issue a letter to the SLA with the board members present. The motion passed and the board issued the letter the next day.

On 12/7, the Public Safety Committee held a meeting to review new liquor license applications. Four applicants attended and were interviewed by the committee. The board and committee chair contact the precinct and no issues were raised by NYPD regarding the applicants.
