**Public Safety and Licensing Committee Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, November 12, 2025, at 6:30 PM

The Public Safety and Licensing Committee met on Wednesday, November 12, 2025, both in-person at the district office and via Zoom Video Communications. The following Board Members attended the Public Safety and Licensing Committee meeting: Nicole Carter (virtual), Sofia Delgado, Margarita Espinosa, Maria Garcia, Shantavia Inabinet, Magdamary Marcano, Reggie Powell, Carmen Rivera and Carol Robinson.

The Public Safety and Licensing Committee discussed the following information:

- **Discussion on a Liquor License Renewal Application**

The Public Safety and Licensing Committee reviewed the liquor license renewal application for J&G Italian Restaurant Corp. (Trade Name San Gennaro) located at 2329 Arthur Avenue. After reviewing the application and discussing the relevant NYC311 complaints, the Public Safety and Licensing Committee will issue a favorable recommendation to the New York State Liquor Authority for this establishment.

- **Discussion on a New Year's Eve All Night Permit Application**

The Public Safety and Licensing Committee reviewed the New Year's Eve all-night permit application for Fiesta Lounge and Restaurant located at 4640 3rd Avenue. After reviewing the application and discussing the relevant NYC311 complaints, the Public Safety and Licensing Committee has decided to withhold their recommendation to the New York State Liquor Authority until they receive a recommendation from the 48th Precinct regarding this New Year's Eve all night permit application.

- **Updates from the 48th Precinct Community Council**

The Public Safety and Licensing Committee was informed that two candidates were interviewed for the Commanding Officer position at the 48th Precinct. Additionally, they received a report that a male victim was found at 2111 Southern Boulevard with a gunshot wound to the head on November 9th at approximately 5:45 PM. This incident is currently an ongoing investigation. They will share further developments on both matters as they become available.
