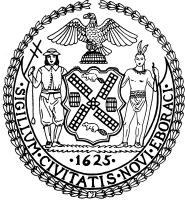

PROPOSED MOTIONS FOR JUNE 24, 2026

(Motions are subject to change.)

1. A motion to adopt the minutes of Bronx Community Board 6's May 2026 Community Board and June 2026 Committee Meetings.
2. A motion to amend the payment schedule for the Best Practices of Out-of-School Programs Evaluation Project, conducted in partnership with Catalyst Research and Development (Dr. Sonia James Wilson), by allocating \$4,250 of the contracted amount to Fiscal Year 2026 and \$2,750 to Fiscal Year 2027.
3. A motion to amend the Bronx Community Board 6's Bylaws by incorporating the following Office Protocol provisions:
"Organizations may request funding of no more than \$1,000 per event and may receive support for no more than three events per calendar year.

Approved organizations shall be reimbursed by the Board following the completion of the event upon submission of an invoice and completion of the required payment process through the Payee Information Portal.

This amendment shall take effect immediately upon adoption on June 24, 2026, and shall not apply retroactively to funding proposals previously approved by the Board."
4. A motion to approve \$100 in funding to the Da People's Assembly for the Love Day Back-to-School Drive and Community Basketball Tournament scheduled for August 15, 2026.
5. A motion to approve \$450 in funding to support the Renee & Friends Block Party for DJ services and event supplies.
6. A motion to issue a letter to the Neighborhood Initiatives Development Corporation (NIDC) requesting that it pursue and facilitate the establishment of a new bank or credit union branch location along East Tremont Avenue.
7. A motion to authorize District Manager Rafael Moure-Punnett to act on behalf of the Public Safety and Licensing Committee for the review and processing of liquor license renewal applications during July and August 2026, and to convene one virtual liquor license review meeting each month during that period.
8. A motion to issue a letter of comment to Bronx Borough President Vanessa L. Gibson regarding the Strategic Policy Statement, identifying key long-term issues affecting our district and proposing strategies and recommendations to address those challenges.
