The following items were discussed:

The committee reviewed and discussed the community visioning meeting summary of September 12, 2017 of the East 181st Street Garden was discussed.

 Discussion of Preliminary Community District Needs and Community Board Budget requests for FY 2019.

We reviewed the Fiscal Year 2019 Community District Needs and Community Board Budget Requests. The committee included the following in our FY 2019 Budget Request:

- Provide a new or expanded park or amenity for Vidalia Park and Belmont Playground
- Reconstruct or upgrade a park or amenity for Vidalia Park and Belmont Playground
- Provide better park maintenance for Bronx River Park, Crotona Malls, Tremont Park and Vincent Ciccarone Playground
- Provide more athletic programming
- Support nonprofit cultural organizations
- Provide more or better equipment to a library

I attended the Council District 15 Town Hall with Mayor de Blasio on Wednesday, October 4, 2017. The Mayor announced funding has been provided for the following:

- \$5.4 million to renovate the soccer field of Quarry Ballfield
- \$1.5 million to renovate Mapes Ballfield
