48<sup>th</sup> Police Precinct Council Meeting Minutes Date: December 19, 2017

Location: 48<sup>th</sup> Police Precinct Claudette Coles, Law Enforcement Committee Chairperson

Captain Andre Brown stated the following crime statistics:

- Overall crime rates have decreased within the 28 day period
- Burglary rates increased from 8 to 14
- Shooting rates year to date period rate has decreased

He also informed the community that the New York City Police Department has resources available if someone is in a domestic violence relationship.

Captain Andre Brown announced that all New York City Police Officers are on social media.

Rafael Moure representing Councilmember Richie Torres, informed us that the Right to Know Act was passed. The Right to Know Act is a legislative package to protect the civil and human rights of New Yorkers in everyday encounters with the NYPD by improving transparency and accountability. Police Officers will now have business cards to hand out to individuals they question, but don't arrest. He also informed us that taxes can be filed in their offices. Lastly, he announced that he will be departing Councilmember Torres' office by the end of December.
