Captain Dan Campbell stated the following crime statistics:

- Overall crime rates have decreased within the 28 day period
- Robberies decreased from 60% to 40%.
- Grand larceny decreased to 23%
- Murder rates increased

He also advised us about identity theft, phone scams, burglaries through open windows and fire escapes.
