48th Precinct Council Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, May 28, 2019 at 7:00 PM

Deputy Inspector Brown stated that overall crime complaints in a 28 day period crime has increased to 12%, grand larceny has decreased to 6%, robbery has increased to 7% and felony has decreased. In addition, he informed us that several arrests regarding to purse snatching and phone theft have increased. He encouraged us to pay attention to our surroundings when using the phone and to not leave visible personal belongings in vehicles. Deputy Inspector Brown announced that motorcycles and bicycles are not permitted on the sidewalks of East Tremont Avenue. He also announced that 1932 Arthur Avenue's lot located on Belmont Avenue will be temporary used by the New York City Police Department's School Safety Division. This will also assist with freeing up parking spaces for the residents on Arthur Avenue.

Officer Mahuad informed us that there is a perpetrator going around attacking young females in the district. The crime prevention officers spoke about the following categories: vehicle safe guards, scam alert, safe horizon, teen dating violence, domestic violence situations, and safe guarding your apartment.

Mr. Alan Nunez representing Solo Pa Mi Gente Community Outreach announced that they will be giving out school backpacks on August 30, 2019 at 9 AM at Our Lady of Mount Camrel Church. They will be accepting donations of school materials and backpacks.

Mr. Artison Ortiz representing New York City Comptroller Scott Stringer stated that the City's economy increased over 18%.
