Sanitation Committee Meeting Minutes

Thursday, January 20, 2022

The Health and Human Services Committee met on Thursday, January 20, 2022 through Zoom Audio and Video Conference. The following board members were present at this meeting: Clarita Bailon, Maria Garcia, Maria Latimer, Matthew Martinez, Magdamary Marcano, Rosa Peraza, Reggie Powell, Carmen Rivera, Kristine Rivera, and Divine Sikanku.

The following information was discussed:

- **Introductory discussion with the District 6 Superintendent of the New York City Department of Sanitation**

The committee was introduced to Superintendent Joseph Fraschilla. Superintendent Fraschilla informed us about the schedule he has in place for his team and his goals for the district. The committee discussed the trash on the sidewalks along East Tremont Avenue. Superintendent Fraschilla informed us that property owners must clean and sweep the sidewalk and gutters next to their properties and the area extending 18 inches into the street from the curb. This rule applies even if someone else caused the dirty condition. This also applies to the tree beds. The committee also discussed that there are chronic dumping areas in our district, for instance, East 179th Street between LaFontaine Avenue and Monterey Avenue. Superintendent Fraschilla will be monitoring this area closely. The committee also discussed that there are vehicles that are violating the alternate side parking rules like East 179th Street between Devoe Avenue and Bronx Park Avenue and Oakland Place between Belmont Avenue and Clinton Avenue. Community Coordinator Carla Leon will be contacting the 48th Police Precinct's Highway and Traffic Sergeant to assist with this issue. The committee also thanked Superintendent Fraschilla for his service throughout the district — they have noticed a significant difference.
