# II. DISCUSSION

Chairperson Evonne Capers informed us that she called this meeting because District Manager John Sanchez sent a policy statement letter to Mayor Bill de Blasio and City Council Speaker Corey Johnson on June 12, 2020 to reduce the New York City Police Department's budget for fiscal year 2021. Chairperson Capers had no knowledge of the letter until she received a call from Mr. Thomas Lucania, Director of Community Boards Unit and Legislative Affairs of Bronx Borough President Ruben Diaz Jr. Mr. Lucania informed her that the letter was posted on the community board's Facebook page and a City Council Member raised concerns about the letter not having her signature on it. Chairperson Capers and Board Members expressed that they are in support of the letter.

Mr. Lucania explained that there is no issue with the content of the letter, however, the letter requires the approval of the Board approval because the letter is policy statement. He also explained that the District Manager is not allowed to composed a letter based on personal opinions using Bronx Community Board #6's letter head. Mr. Lucania recommended that the Board vote to approve the letter and to resend the letter including the Chairperson's signature.

A roll call attendance was taken confirming quorum with the presence of eighteen (18) members.

## X. ADOPTION OF MOTIONS

A motion to accept the letter sent to Mayor Bill de Blasio and City Council Speaker Corey Johnson on June 12, 2020 and resend the letter with the signature of Chairperson Capers was made by Mr. Gil Simmons, seconded by Ms. Maria Garcia, and adopted by a vote of sixteen in favor, zero opposed, and two abstentions.
