Health and Human Services Committee Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, October 20, 2020

The Health and Human Services Committee met on Tuesday, October 20, 2020 through Zoom Audio and Video Conference. The following board members were present at this meeting: Clarita Bailon, Cornell Brown, Milagros Cancel, Assana Lloyd, Carmen Rivera, and Jacquetta Whaley.

The following information was discussed:

• Discussion of the Preliminary Community District Needs and Community Board Budget Requests for Fiscal Year 2022.

The committee members selected the following expense requests:

- Provide more information and services related to STIs, HIV/AIDS, and family planning
- Other programs to address public health issues requests
- Create or promote programs for education and awareness on preventing chronic diseases including quitting smoking, nutrition, physical activity, etc.
- Create or promote programs to decrease children's emergency department visits for asthma and prevent injuries
- Create or promote programs to de-stigmatize mental health needs and encourage treatment
- Increase health and safety inspections, e.g. for restaurants and childcare programs
- Animal and pest control requests including reducing rat and mosquito populations
- Continue Crime Prevention/Victim Assistance Program for Seniors
- Funding for a new senior center program
- Increase transportation services capacity
- Expand homelessness prevention programs
- Provide programs for homeless veterans
- Provide rental assistance/vouchers for permanent housing
- Provide, expand, or enhance Fair Fares
- Expand, or enhance Emergency Food Assistance Program (EFAP)
- Provide social services for domestic violence survivors (legal services, counseling, referral to supportive services, etc.)

The committee members provided certain specifications for the items above:

- Other programs to address public health issues requests: Focus on domestic violence
- Funding for a new senior center program: Provide technology training
- Increase transportation services capacity: Increase Access-A-Ride funding for more rides
- Provide, expand, or enhance Fair Fares: Maintain funding

The Health and Human Services Committee meets every third Tuesday of the month.
