Discussion of Pedestrian Safety Improvement Proposal by DOT of Intersection of Manhattan College Parkway at Delafield Avenue

This intersection has met the federal warrant for an all way stop control and DOT will install a new stop sign for westbound traffic on Manhattan College Parkway. In order to improve pedestrian visibility, shorten crossings, and slow turns DOT will install new crosswalks in the north, east and west legs of the intersection, painted median tip extensions on the west side of the intersection, and painted curb extensions on the east side of the intersection, as the attached diagram shows. Roughly five parking spots will be removed for the median tips on the west leg of the intersection. A drawing of the plan is attached.

Request for Street Activity Permit for Kingsbridge Terrace Community Block Party Sponsored by KBT4KIDZ

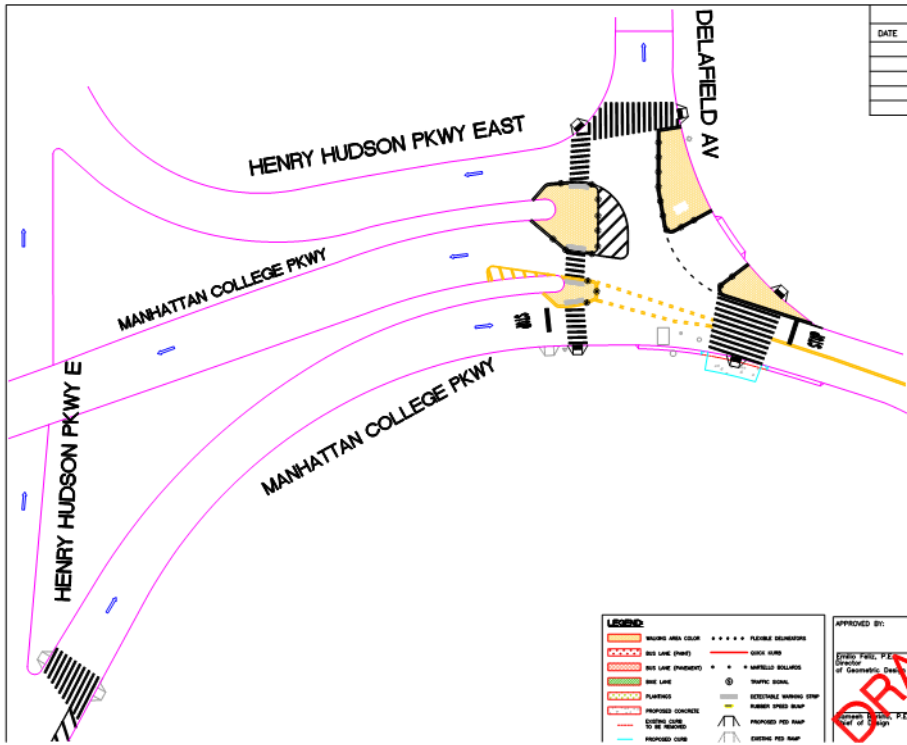
