| Whereas, Department of Parks and Recreation needs additional funding for operations and maintenance of parks and green spaces; and  |
| Whereas when he was Brooklyn Borough President Mr. Adams recognized how vital the parks have been to New Yorkers during the pandemic, saying, "In the moments of this pandemic our green spaces provided a place for us to gather, express ourselves, and to simply catch a breath of fresh air"; and |
| Whereas all five borough presidents have endorsed the principle of 1% for parks; and  |
| Whereas the City Council is holding hearings on the Mayor's proposed budget in March;   |

## **Bronx Community Board No. 8**

Request to Co-Name the Corner of Hudson Manor Terrace and West 237th Street

in honor of I. William "Bill" Stone as "Bill Stone"

Full Board Meeting on Tuesday, February 8, 2022

WHEREAS, a request for co-naming a street in memory of the late I. William "Bill" Stone has been made and meets the mandatory requirements for a Community Board 8 Street Naming by being deceased for greater than two years and has been nominated by three or more organizations which are on the list required to be kept by the Community Board under the NYC Charter;

**WHEREAS**, the location bearing the name change has a specific connection to his life as he resided nearby at 3801 Hudson Manor Terrace for nearly 60 years;

WHEREAS, this street co-naming has been endorsed by River Spring Living/Hebrew Home at Riverdale, Riverdale Jewish Center, Bronx Developmental Disabilities Council and the Interagency Council of Developmental Disabilities Agencies along with additional endorsements from former Community Board 8 Chairs Robert Fanuzzi, Dan Padernacht, Rosemary Ginty, current Chair Laura Spalter and City Council Member Eric Dinowitz;

**WHEREAS**, Bill Stone served our community as an active member of Community Board 8 for nearly 40 years and during his tenure chaired the Health & Hospitals and Libraries Committees and was Treasurer, Vice Chair and served three terms as Chair of Community Board 8. Additionally, he served on the Board of Directors of AHRC NYC providing much needed services for people with disabilities for nearly 50 years, eventually leading the organization as President for three of those years.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,** Bronx Community Board 8 supports the co-naming of the corner of Hudson Manor Terrace and West 237<sup>th</sup> Street in honor of Bill Stone.
