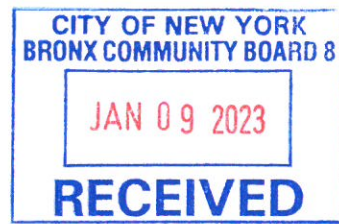

Good Afternoon BX CB 08,

I am writing to express my ardent support towards the efforts to rename the intersection on Broadway adjacent to the Lloyd's Carrot Cake store front. This street renaming is something myself and my family are very passionate about, and it is something I had multiple conversations about with my mother, Betty Campbell-Adams, before her sudden tragic passing in 2020.

I've also expressed my eagerness to rename this street to both Bronx BP Gibson, as well as Assemblyman Dinowitz, both of whom expressed their support for the renaming. So to hear that this may be coming to fruition is very exciting news.

Thinking through specific logistics of the renaming, I'd just like to callout a few details/requests:

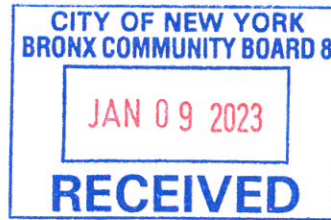
- Location:
  - We are insistent that the renaming should be the intersection on Broadway adjacent to Lloyd's Carrot Cake - Directly in front of the Tortoise & Hare storefront: 6161 Broadway
  - We've heard in the past that this may pose an issue since there currently isn't an exact street number to this intersection.
    - This is where our efforts in the past have fallen to the wayside. We feel any other intersection doesn't make sense and would feel forced.
- Naming:
  - We've gone back and forth on the actual naming of the street, keeping in mind how our mom (Betty) envisioned it, but also making sure we take this as an opportunity to commemorate all that she meant to our community. Keeping this in mind we think it's best that the text is as follows
    - Lloyd's Carrot Cake Way
      - In loving memory of Betty Campbell-Adams (subtext)
- Timing:
  - We would love it if the renaming could align with the timing of the first annual gala we are planning, in May for the Betty & Lloyd Adams Foundation, which we have begun to establish. This would also fall around the time of Betty's birthday as well.

Happy to hear any feedback or thoughts. Again, I can't strongly enough express our gratitude for all the support with this effort.

Please be sure to keep me on any and all necessary correspondences moving forward.

Her gracious spirit and commitment to bettering the neighborhood continues through her children today. 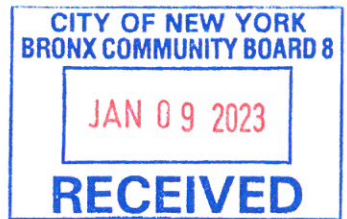
We look forward to celebrating Betty and Lloyd’s through this meaningful dedication.

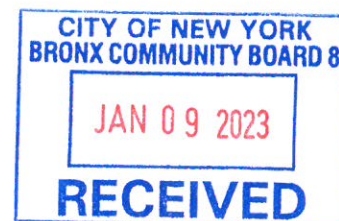
