Dear Ciara Gannon,

I hope you are well. I am writing today to notify you about a planned safety improvement at Manhattan College Parkway at Delafield Avenue. This complicated multi-leg intersection is immediately in front of the Fieldston School and does not currently have stop controls for westbound vehicles. I am pleased to inform you that this intersection met the federal warrant for an all way stop control, and DOT will install a new stop sign for westbound traffic on Manhattan College Parkway.

In order to improve pedestrian visibility, shorten crossings, and slow turns DOT will install new crosswalks in the north, east and west legs of the intersection, painted median tip extensions on the west side of the intersection, and painted curb extensions on the east side of the intersection, as the attached diagram shows. Roughly five parking spots will be removed for the median tips on the west leg of the intersection.

DOT would like to move forward on implementing this project in 2022, please let me know if the Community Board has any questions or concerns.
