The Chair called on Bryan Glover from Bronx Council of the Arts to start his presentation. Mr. Glover is the Deputy Director of Grants & Programs. The BCA is funded by the City & State of New York and their mission is to award grants to individual artist or Cultural Affairs Bronx local groups. BCA works with senior centers but not schools at this time. BCA has workshops in Art and Writing for artists. BCA has a gallery at Hostos College called Longwood Gallery where they display artists' works for the community to enjoy. Last year they distributed about \$800,000 in grants back into the community.
