WHEREAS Seniors citizens in our community have an increased risk of isolation and depression due to social distancing requirements; and

WHEREAS New York City has implemented the LinkNYC program to provide free internet access; and

WHEREAS Out of approximately 1,869 LinkNYC locations only one kiosk is located within Bronx Community Board 8; and

WHEREAS there will be a need for high speed internet access after the COVID-19 global pandemic

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT; Bronx Community Board 8 calls upon New York City to expand the current LinkNYC kiosk network to include more of Community Board 8 with particular attention to underserved communities
