1. Street Racing on local streets in community.

Chair Padernacht stated that he has been in discussions with Public Safety Chair Ed Green, the CB8 District Manager and Captain Girven of the 50th Police precinct regarding the issue and enforcement by law enforcement. Chair Padernacht stated that the 50th Precinct has sought assistance from Highway One and the New York State Police.

4. Discussion and concerns of retaining wall on Dash Place.

Chair Padernacht stated that with construction at 9 Dash Place and 3893 Waldo Avenue, the Community Board has received concerns about the retaining wall that holds up the street on Dash Place. Chair Padernacht stated that we have asked the developers of the respective properties to present their Builder's Pavement Plan to the Traffic and Transportation Committee. Chair Padernacht stated that the Committee will continue to monitor the developments and any potential impact on the retaining wall. Chair Padernacht stated that the Board Office has notified DOT and DOB about the existence of the retaining wall at the location of these developments.
