

CB8's Capital & Expense Budget FY 22 Budget Documents Priorities- FY 22

Join us at the Full Board Meeting & Public Hearing on February 9th.

The New York City Charter mandates a role for community boards in the annual preparation and review of the City's budget. Each spring, the Board's committees consider the most pressing needs of the community. A public hearing is held by the full Board at its October meeting. In February the process is followed again when the Board reviews the Mayor's responses & preliminary budget for the coming fiscal year. 
