1.	<u>PARKS – DPR - Redesign and reconstruction of Bailey Playground</u> Reconstruction of play equipment; safety surfacing and fencing along the Major Deegan Expressway. Incorporate adjacent Tibbett's Tail area into an expanded Bailey Playground. Reduce asphalt and add green space.	1.
2.	<u>HOUSING (NYCHA) Funding for facade work and roof repair</u> for New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA) Marble Hill Houses.	2.
3.	<u>T&T:DOT – Intersection of Broadway and West 230th Street: Realign & reconstruct the intersection to create safer intersection for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorist, including traffic exiting the Deegan.Expy</u>	New
4.	<u>PUBLIC SAFETY (NYPD) – Argus Security Cameras:</u> Captures continuous (24 hour) high-definition video footage, with range of up to two blocks from camera. Footage can be accessed by any 50 th Precinct Police Officer; is often reviewed to identify perpetrators, license plates; Can be deterrent to crime (auto theft, local business security, etc.). 5.	<u>AGING – DFTA – Older Adult Center Transportation:</u> Enable Centers to operate their own bus/van transportation for participation in their nutrition, health and social programs, day trips, etc. Walkability in many sections of our community is difficult having steep hills, step streets and long blocks.	16.
6.	<u>T&T:DOT - West 231st Street Countdown Clocks:</u> Bus shelter and countdown clocks on East side of West 231st Street between Broadway and Albany Crescent Avenue	17.
7.	<u>PARKS – DPR - Marble Hill Playground Lighting:</u> Install park lighting to light the pathways and activity areas within the interior of Marble Hill Playground	<u>11.</u>

8.	<u>ELCA (CULTURAL AFFAIRS) Kingsbridge Historical Society:</u> Building is landmarked and urgently needs roof repair to fix leaks. Building is a community resource with programs of educational significance.	6.
9.	<u>Housing (NYCHA) Rehabilitation of the Community Center</u> for New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA) Marble Hill Houses.	7.
10.	<u>PUBLIC SAFETY (NYPD) – Portable Camera System:</u> Used to monitor areas where Argus Cameras can't be installed (e.g., Van Cortlandt Park). If crime is trending upward in a particular area, 50 th Precinct can easily install the portable unit in that area and remove it when it's needed in another location.	9.
11.	<u>T&T (DOT) - West 235th Street Sidewalk:</u> Reconstruct West 235th Street between Independence Ave and Henry Hudson Parkway West adding sidewalk on the north side of the street and sewer infrastructure to improve pedestrian access and eliminate unsafe ponding.	24.
12.	<u>PARKS – DPR - Reconstruction of Old Fort Four Park</u> Reconstruction improvements of playground equipment, benches, greenspace, stone walls and fencing including improved lighting for the basketball courts	15.
13.	<u>PARKS – DPR - Restoration of Lower Brust Park Staircase</u> Restoration of flagstone, pavers, steps and handrails	14.
14.	<u>ELCA (DOE) - PS24BX Playground rehab and update:</u> needs rubber flooring to prevent injuries; needs updated equipment.	New
15.	<u>E&S – DEP – Spuyten Duyvil Waterfront CSO Improvements:</u> Mitigate Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) outfalls into Spuyten Duyvil Creek adjacent to Spuyten Duyvil and Marble Hill Metro North Railroad stations with a living shoreline and green infrastructure along DEP easements.	13.
16.	<u>T&T (DOT) – Intersection of Riverdale Avenue and West 238th Street</u> near Henry Hudson Parkway Overpass: Realign & reconstruct the intersection to create safer intersection for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists.	New

17.	<u>PARKS – DPR - Equipment for Litter Collection</u> Additional mini-packer vehicle to reach remote areas for litter collection in Van Cortlandt Park in District 13 and one packer vehicle to be assigned in District 8	New
18.	<u>T&T (DOT) - Independence Avenue Sidewalk:</u> Reconstruct sidewalk on east side of Independence Avenue across the width of mapped, but unbuilt portion of West 242nd Street.	New
19.	<u>Eco Dev – SBS/EDC/DoITT – Small Business Rewards Mobile App/ Digital Currency</u> – Development of Mobile App rewards program for small businesses to reward and redeem points (“Bronx Bucks”)	New
20.	<u>T&T:DOT – West 235th Street Pedestrian Walkway:</u> Reconstruct Pedestrian Walkway over the Henry Hudson Parkway between West 235 th Street and West 236 th Street.	26.
21.	<u>T&T:DOT – Feasibility Study West 235th Street Pedestrian Walkway:</u> Feasibility Study for ADA Ramps to be added to the pedestrian walkway over Henry Hudson Parkway between West 235 th Street and West 236 th Street.	26.
22.	<u>T&T - DOT - Van Cortlandt Park South Step Street:</u> Reconstruct the step street from Van Cortlandt Park South to Gale Place •	3.
23.	<u>T&T - DOT – Rehabilitate Step Streets:</u> • W229 from Kingsbridge Terrace to Sedgwick Avenue • W231 between Sedgwick Ave and Kingsbridge Terrace	10.
