



offering solid curriculum to enable their students to be ready for college. Currently, the school has only one grade and hopes to increase a grade each future year. The school also services special needs students with IEP testing and educational services as appropriate.

The Chair called on Tatiana to discuss NYC Council legislation 0080-2026, sponsored by Councilwoman Gale Brewer-Nutrition & Education in NYC Schools. The legislation calls for a report to be generated from a study. The committee members were interested in the benefits of nutritional information and who would be part of the discussions and program requirements as the proposal developed.

1. ELCA-DOE: P.S.95-Sheila Mencher School-Requesting funding to update their auditorium
2. ELCA-DOE: United Charter High School for the Humanities-Request funding for technology equipment to support their development of their digital journalism program
3. ELCA-DOE: MS/HS 141-Riverdale, Kingsbridge Academy-Requesting funding to restore bathrooms
4. ELCA-DOE: Atmosphere Charter School-Requesting funding for Chromebooks for students and staff
5. ELCA-DOE: Am Park Neighborhood School-Requesting funding to upgrade security system. The safety and security of our students is our highest priority
6. ELCA-DOE: Amber Charter School-Requesting funding for the school's Steam program lab equipment/robotics
7. ELCA-DOE: The Marie Curie High School-Requesting funding to upgrade 1 Male-1 Female bathroom

#### EXPENSE

1. ELCA-NYPL: Requesting funding to increase our 5 branch libraries to 7-day service
2. ELCA-DOE: The Marie Curie High School-Requesting funding to install window shades in classrooms
3. ELCA-DOE: MS/HS 141- Riverdale, Kingsbridge Academy-Requesting funding to replace old furniture in classrooms

The Chair called on Aga Chen, Manager of the Spuyten Duyvil Library, said all was good at the branch.

The Chair called on Rebecca Brown, Barbier Manager of Riverdale branch, said she would send the May Calander tomorrow.
