Introductions

- Welcome –Thanks to Jericho Project and William Mckeithan for hosting the meeting. Participants introduced themselves
- Confirmed no objection to move approval of minutes to later in meeting
- Chair regrets that meeting did not draw residents

Speakers - Bridget Maybury, RN and Evan Podolak, PhD - James J Peters VA Medical Center, Bronx

The speakers provided background, research, statistics, risk factors, root cause and other information to raise awareness of suicide and suicide prevention. The meeting focused on older adults and veterans. Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death in the US, most often by firearms. One out of four attempted suicides in adults 65+ results in death, with far lower rate in younger people. Highest risk group is white, male, over age 85. Older veterans have similar rates. Younger veterans have lower suicide rates. There is no direct correlation between suicide and number of tours of duty. Every VA has a suicide prevention coordinator.

Depression is the leading cause - life changes/losses as well as failing health (increasing with co-morbidities) and chronic pain. Depression, if treated, is 90% successful. Recommend that primary care and hospital/nursing home staff screen for depression, considering life changes, to prevent suicide. Ask about suicidal thoughts, validate the individual's experience, and encourage/expedite care.
