Chairperson's report included the following education issues:

- -New policy entitled "empowerment" where principal's have more control over school spending, staffing and curriculum; also get more money;
- -City math scores showing scores decline thru upper grades;
- -Pre K, Kindergarten and 1st grade children who wish to apply for two new Region #1 Gifted and Talented classes will have to take the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test and GRS (Gifted Rating Scale); applications can be obtained through Region 1;
- -elimination of evening H.S. classes; instead there will be an extended school day for struggling High School students;
- -U.F.T. workshop for parents to help their child succeed in school on October 26, 2006;
- -Education Option for Children with Special Needs on November 1, 2006;

Report from Marvin Shelton, President of Community Education Council of District 10 on proposed Region 1 Gifted and Talented classes starting in September 2007 at P.S. 24 and P.S. 54.
