Guest Speaker, Phillip Sayer Scharper, the new Principal of PS 24, was introduced by the Chair. Mr. Scharper then outlined his background in the Arts, as well as in Education. In general he advocated providing opportunities for <u>all</u> children to achieve success in academics, social, emotional and physical areas of development and respect for the similarities and differences of the school's diverse population. He hopes that the parents, the teachers and administrators will work together and with the children to achieve these goals. Mr. Scharper then answered questions asked by the committee members.

- mixed report card for NY students proficiency on the 4th and 8th grade math and reading scores.
- 200 schools are to be selected to receive merit pay bonuses based mainly on the tests students take next spring.
- funding for after school programs known as "Out-of-School Time Initiative" has gone up from \$46 million to \$121 million by next year, so more children will be serviced.
- read E-Mail from 2 PS 95 parents opposed to plans for placing a new school within their building causing additional overcrowding. They were invited to attend this Education meeting, but did not show.
