Methodist Home for Nursing & Rehabilitation

Ms. Baez, who is new to the Methodist Home, stated that the facility, which is not-for-profit, has 120 beds, all private rooms. She explained that the Methodist Home was formerly served long-term residence only, but now provides sub-acute rehabilitation, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and wound care on a short-term basis. The facility also provides hospice/palliative care.

Tour: Marble Hill Community Center

Ruby Palma, who works with the Marble Hill Garden, led a brief tour of the facilities and programs at the Marble Hill Community Center, which includes a daily senior center, daily after-school program for elementary school-age children (3:30-6 pm) and teens (6-10 pm), and an adult program on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

New Business

Ms. Palma suggested that Workfare placements, to the extent possible, should assign people to positions in their own community, and that HRA public assistance centers provide computer access so that time spent waiting can be used productively.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 9 pm.
