Recommendations for a bylaws change concerning the CB 8 Land Use Committee

Remaining the same		Differences
1.	Standing Committee	Establish a roster of committee members

Recommended By-Laws Change

Article VI Section 7

Land Use Committee – The membership of the Land Use Committee shall be limited to Appointed Board Members. Those Board Members who join the Committee shall be subject to the rules which require regular attendance at meetings as a basis for continuing membership. -Only members of the Land Use Committee can vote at a Land Use Committee meeting and provided that such committee members were present at the hearing. Absence from the hearing shall qualify for "abstention for cause" on a resolution offered by the Land Use Committee at a general Board meeting.

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Present Language.

Land Use Committee – The membership of the Land Use Committee shall be limited to Appointed Board Members. Those Board Members who join the Committee shall be subject to the rules which require regular attendance at meetings as a basis for continuing membership. Nevertheless, any member of the Board shall have the right to participate in a vote held by the Land Use Committee, provided such a vote is held on a substantive matter following a hearing at which members of the public have spoken, and provided further that such Board Members were present at the hearing.

To the extent permitted by the City Charter and other applicable laws, the Land Use Committee shall be authorized to speak for and on behalf of the full Board, following, and pursuant to, a Land Use Committee vote on an issue as to which there is a time limit for Board response to a City agency, providing the following conditions have been met:

- 4. All Board Members have received notice of the Land Use Committee meeting and such notice has included language indicating that the full Board may not have an opportunity to timely vote on the issue and that the Committee decision may therefore constitute the Board's position;
- The mandated time limit for Board input to the relevant City agency will expire between the date of the Land Use Committee vote and the date of the next regularly scheduled Board meeting; and
- 6. The Board Chairperson has informed the Land Use Committee Chair, by the date of the Land Use Committee vote that no special Board meeting will be called to consider the issue, and the participants in the Committee meeting are made aware of this information prior to the Committee vote.
