- 1. Approval of minutes of November 23, 2010 Unanimously approved.
- 2. Presentation by Heather Kagedan on Bullying
  - Focus is on cyber bullying.
  - Involves emails, text messages, web pages (hate web pages), video games and social networking sites.
  - More intense: more witnesses, anonymous nature often leads to crueler taunts.
  - Signs: Depression, uneasiness about school, avoids cell or computer.

New York has legislation to address the problem, but it is somewhat loose on a curriculum requirement mandated for middle schools.

School Response: There are specific programs, but these are not "cyber bullying" specific – may fall through the cracks.

Ms. Kagedan noted 141 is proactive in addressing bullying.

What to do? See attached handout.

Riverdale Mental Health Association offers support services for victims, but also for the bullies to address why they do this. Contact Ms. Kagedan directly for more information.
