WHEREAS, this establishment has been served numerous summonses by the 50th Precinct of the New York City Police Department, including failure to properly post security information AND

WHEREAS, this establishment was recently closed for 2 days for failure to hold insurance,

AND in the interest of safety for both our community and for college students temporarily living here,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Bronx Community Board 8 by unanimous vote, and on unanimous vote of its Public Safety Committee, hereby urges the State Liquor Authority to NOT renew the liquor license for Serenity Lounge.
