Detective Rodriguez report: from January 1 to January 15, 37 crimes, up from 35 last year. Eight robberies, including an arrest on 231st of twin brothers for whom NYPD had pictures. Six felony arrests. Five burglaries. Fifteen grand larcenies including ID theft. Four stolen cars.

Chair: Board office was called re 3 car break-ins in last 2 weeks. Detective Rodriguez reported one arrest re breaking and entering into a car.

Chair: 2 alarm fire on Kingsbridge Road at 215 West Kingsbridge Road. 81 Firehouse responded to abandoned house with squatters.

Chair: letter re The Lounge. Altercation on Post Road. Squadcar came and left at 3:30 a.m.

Report from Red Cross distributed. Letter to Bronx D.A. re speaker on gangs distributed.

All liquor license applications approved, except 123 West Kingsbridge Road by vote in favor A. Feldmeier, E. Corcino, L. Parker and H. Young. R. Fanuzzi abstained.

Resident Bernice Spillert, living on Henry Hudson Parkway facing Independence Avenue complained about noise from teens skateboarding in the M.S. 141 arcade. Will be followed up by Councilman Koppell's office and by letter from CB 8.

Resident living on corner of Strong Street complained of break-ins. Police will investigate.
