The Public Safety Committee met on Thursday, February 21, 2008 at 7:30 p.m. at the 50th Police Precinct. The new Captain of the 50th Precinct, John D'Adamo, was welcomed by the Chair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as written.

Seven applications for liquor license renewals were approved. One, for Jay's Place, was held over to our next meeting for a compliance issue.

Jane Walmsley, representing CERT, spoke to us on a number of issues. She intends to attend our meetings regularly. She stated that 20 members of the community were previously trained, and that there are currently three new trainees. Across the city, The Bronx is the weakest link with the smallest membership.

The committee is considering a resolution urging the City Council to require all senior residences to have an emergency generator.
