In view of multiple complaints from the community, Detective Rodriguez reviewed with the owner that if there are further complaints, precinct officers will enter to inspect and take action. The owners stated that they are working to decrease noise levels and to address parking problems. Van Cortlandt Golf House, another new application, was also approved.

The committee will meet next on March 5, 2009 at 7:00 PM, at the precinct, in a joint meeting with the Community Board's Parks Committee to discuss summer activities in the parks.
