Detective Rodriguez report: crime down, rape down 25%, robbery down 17%, felony down 6%, burglary down 17%, grand larceny up 1%, stolen cars up 4%, arrests up. Detective Rodriguez described the Bait Car, a technique in use for 13 to 15 years, and used as a decoy loaded with items such as laptops or GPS devices. He reported that arrests have been made, since people have tried to break in.

Liquor Licenses:

Silhouette Restaurant, 5658 Broadway. Seats max 150, no dancing or live music. Owners promised to investigate purchase of a scanner to prevent underage drinking. Projected opening: Spring 2010. Approved unanimously.

Dubay Lounge, alteration permit. Unanimously decided to table.
